Jena 2010 Traditional measures of economic disparities among Americans of different race, gender, geographic location, and education level consider only material well-being, so that making two groups economically "equal" is as simple as matching their monetary incomes. This narrow focus on income may not, however, lead to a complete understanding of economic prosperity in the United States. Therefore, although black and white incomes have not converged fully, the over-all disparity decreases when health is incorporated into the analysis.
