When I started teaching in the classroom, that's when I started taking pictures. I'm a visual learner, so for me it's easier to teach visually. I find most of my students are visual learners as well. The pictures really come in handy to explain things in the classroom, and also in the car when my students don't fully understand what I'm asking them to do. For example, while they're driving or doing maneuvers like uphill or downhill parking, three point turns, parallel parking or backing up in a straight line. Over a five year period I have taken a lot of pictures, and use them every day when teaching in the car or in the classroom. My students liked them so much I decided to put them into a book. It has taken me five years to finish Teaching New Drivers to Drive. My students are always saying that the Driver's Ed book tells them what they need to do, but not how to do it. I wrote this book to help students of all ages understand what it is they need to do in order to drive safely. I have taught thousands of students who needed to get their Massachusetts licenses, from
