2007 Avec ce recueil qui reunit dix-huit contributions, nous poursuivons la quête collective entreprise dans le volume *L'énonciation médiatisée* ou, pour éviter toute confusion conceptuelle et terminologique, une distinction avait été introduite entre médiatif et énonciation médiatisée.

Rappelons que, selon cette distinction, le terme de médiatif désigne une catégorie grammaticale qui, fondée sur des oppositions formelles au sein du système grammatical d'une langue, permet à l'énonciateur de présenter des situations (...) dont il n'assume pas la responsabilité pour en avoir eu connaissance par voie indirecte, d'où la possibilité pour lui de manifester divers degrés de distance par rapport au contenu de son propre message (Guentcheva 1996: 11). Notons que le médiatif exclut de son champ

semantique tout fait présente comme un constat ou lie à la perception visuelle, que les degrés de distance que l'énonciateur manifeste à l'égard du contenu propositionnel du message transmis, laissent l'énoncé en dehors de toute assignation en vrai ou en faux (ibid.) et qu'il ne relève pas de la modalité épistémique. En revanche, l'énonciation médiatisée n'implique pas nécessairement de procédés grammaticalisés qui s'organisent en un système cohérent au sein de la langue, bien que, dans un contexte particulier, une forme verbale puisse recevoir une valeur médiative ou qu'un élément syntaxique comme certains adverbes ou expressions adverbiales puisse conduire à une interprétation médiative de la phrase. Rappelons également que les contributions au recueil en question attestaient de la complexité du phénomène médiatif, de la variété de procédés morphosyntaxiques et lexicaux mis en œuvre dans l'expression de la notion de médiation (ou de médiatisation)

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et de la relation complexe que la categorie du mediatif entretient d'une part avec la valeur de resultativite liee au parfait et d'autre part, avec la modalite epistemique. C'est le questionnement sur cette variete de procedes morphosyntaxiques et sur la pertinence de la notion de mediation ou de mediatisation dans d'autres langues du monde qui est a l'origine de ce second volume.

*Semantic Plurality* Laure Gardelle 2019-11-07 This monograph proposes a comparative approach to all the ways of denoting 'more than one' entity, from collective and aggregate nouns (with the first-ever typology), to count plurals, partly substantivised adjectives and conjoined NPs. This semantic feature approach to plurality, which cuts across number, the count/non-count distinction, and lexical/NP levels, reveals a very consistent Scale of Unit Integration, which establishes clear-cut boundaries for collective nouns, and accommodates cases such as three elephant, cattle or a chain of islands. The study also offers a refined understanding

language in the North, "Words of the Inuit" is a timely contribution to understanding one of the world's most resilient Indigenous languages. *Computational Linguistics in the Netherlands 1998* F. van Eynde 2000 This volume provides a selection of the papers which were presented at the ninth conference on Computational Linguistics in the Netherlands (Leuven, 1998). **L'emprise du sens** Andrée Borillo 1999 Réunir les très nombreuses personnes qui, de par leurs activités de recherche ou d'enseignement, ont eu la chance de croiser la route d'Andrée Borillo et, parfois même, de faire un bout de chemin avec elle ne nous a pas paru raisonnable. Outre le fait qu'une telle entreprise aurait nécessité plusieurs volumes d'hommages, l'adéquation des thématiques traitées de même que l'homogénéité du contenu ne nous semblaient pas suffisamment garanties. Nous avons donc volontairement limité cet ouvrage à un petit nombre de contributeurs,
